Employment Opportunity: 2019 Summer Day Camp Leader (Jr/Sr)

Scope of Work

This position involves direct supervision and leadership with children, administrative duties and the overall supervision of day camp staff and volunteers. Candidates should be highly organized with strong leadership skills and past experience in day camp programs. This program is held in a combination of a day camp and classroom setting. Position may be based out of Renfrew Park Community Centre or Falaise Community Hall.

Responsibilities

- Responsible for the safety, leadership and supervision of children between the ages of 6 to 12 years
- Assists in the planning and organization of activities for children.
- Lead programs and activities under the direction of the Day Camp Supervisor
- Discipline children using teaching, encouragement and natural and logical consequence methods
- Provides direction to volunteers
- Assists with program promotion
- Maintains good communication with parents, children, co-workers and volunteers
- Responds to first aid needs and unusual incidents
- Cleans up and secures room leaving it presentable for evening programs/community groups

Qualifications

- Previous experience working in a day camp setting
- Excellent organizational, supervisory and interpersonal and communication skills
- Diverse knowledge of activities and outings suitable for children 6-12 yr olds
- Demonstrates knowledge in dealing with emergencies, unusual incidents and behavior challenges
- Previous supervisory experience preferable
- Ability to work independently and contribute positively to a team environment
- Familiarity and knowledge of computer software Microsoft Word or Publisher
- Demonstrates high levels of initiative and resourcefulness

- Valid First Aid & CPR certification
- Ability to speak a second language an asset, particularly Cantonese or Mandarin
- Familiarity with and sensitivity to providing services in a multi-cultural community

Necessary Conditions for Consideration

- Required to complete a Police Record Search
- This position is made possible by the Canada Summer Jobs funding; all positions are subject to funding approval.
- In compliance with Canada Summer Jobs funding, applicants must be able to work full time (30-40hrs/week) weekly during the project period.

Terms of Employment

Employment may be at a daycamp at Renfrew Park Community Centre or Slocan Hall

- Slocan Hall position is a youth orientated focus
- Rate of pay \$14.50-\$16.00/hr +4-6% in lieu of benefits (wage based on experience with daycamps)
- Staff are expected to be available full time (30-40hrs/week, between 8:30am-4pm)
- Staff are expected to be available for mandatory training on Sunday Jun 23 from 9am-5pm.
- Camp dates run from Jul 2-Aug 30 (Renfrew), July 2-Aug 23 (Falaise Hall) with some preparation days required before start of camp.
